



# SPOILER ALERT: ROM COM

## WEEK 3 - BASED ON THE SEPTEMBER 16TH/17TH MESSAGE

1. What is your favorite romantic comedy? What about that movie/show makes it your favorite?

Watch the Spoiler Alert: "Rom Com" Recap Video with your group and answer the following questions:

1. Sometimes when we see movies or shows there is a relationship we connect to and others we don't. Can you share one TV/MOVIE couple you connect to and one you absolutely do not?
2. When Peter writes this letter he is challenging everyone to have a different perspective. During this message or recap was there anything there that made you uncomfortable? If so, what was it and why?
3. Peter first addresses how wives are to "submit" to their husbands in reference to the chapter before (a heart posture of servitude). This is often a hot topic issue for Christians and non-Christians. What gives you pause when hearing this? What parts do you agree with?
4. Peter addresses husbands and shares that they ought to be someone worth submitting to. What challenges did you see with this? What about this possibly gave you hope?
5. During the message/recap video we heard the difference between LORDship and LEADERship, but what do you think the biggest difference is between them? Why do you think the lines between the two are blurred at times?
6. Peter finally addresses Christians and how they are to live in relation to others. He challenges Christians (with essentially a summarized beatitudes message) and tells them to think of others higher than themselves. Is this something you strive for or struggle with?
7. Being submissive to Christ is often one of the hardest battles we face due to our pride/control. Are there one or two things you feel comfortable sharing with your group that you could submit over to Christ? Can the group do anything to help or come alongside you in this?
8. Is there a person in your life that you know you could treat better? What is one way you can "do for one what you wish you could do for everyone" this week?
9. How can the group be praying for you this week?
